## *Purpose*

- To provide assessment and referral for long-term care services in the community
- To provide a voluntary alternative to nursing-home care
- To provide home-care services to persons who are income eligible with appropriate health-care needs
- To provide assessment of “level of care” when required for individuals who are seeking nursing-home care
